GRAMMAR 1

SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE

- We use the simple present tense to talk about daily routines, habits, regular activities likes & dislikes.

Rules

- We use the base form of the verb to form the present simple tense.
- In general, in the third person singular the verb ends in “-s”.
- We add “-es” to verbs ending in “-o, ch, -sh, -ss, -x” or “-z”.
- Some verbs end in a consonant + -y. We remove the “-y” and add “-ies” in the third person singular.
- We use “Do” or “Does” before the subject to make a question in the simple present tense.
- We use “do not / don’t” or “does not / doesn’t” between the subject and the verb to make a negative sentence.



Affirmative (+)

I You We They	get up early.
He She It	gets up early.



Negative (-)

I You We They	don't get up early.
He She It	doesn't get up early.



Question (?)

Do	I you we they	get up early?
Does	he she it	get up early?

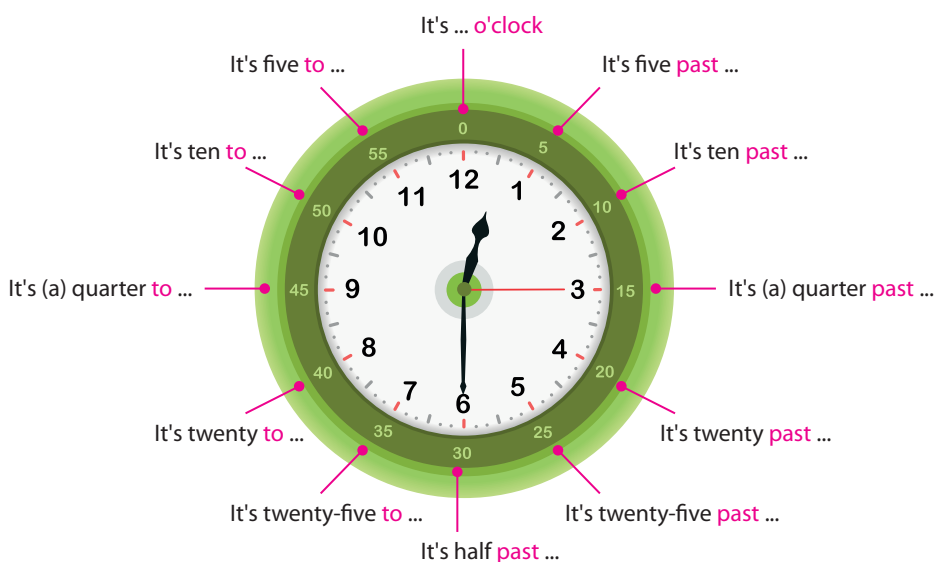

TELLING THE TIME

- The common question forms we use to ask for the time are: What time is it? / What is the time?
- We use **"It is"** or **"It's"** to respond to the questions that ask for the time right now.
It is half past six (6:30).
It's ten to one (12:50).
- We use the structure **at + time** when giving the time of a specific event.
Linda has lunch at midday. (12:00).
They leave home at a quarter to eight (7:45).
My classes start at nine o'clock (9:00).
- We use **a.m. (am)** for the morning and **p.m. (pm)** for the afternoon and night.
2 a.m. → Two o'clock in the morning.
2 p.m. → Two o'clock in the afternoon.

GRAMMAR 3

ORDINAL NUMBERS

- We use ordinal numbers to tell the dates.
- There are two ways of giving the date in English.
 - Month + Day: January 25** – January the twenty fifth
 - Day + Month: 25th January** – The twenty fifth of January
- Years are normally divided into two parts; the first two digits and the last two digits.
 - 2016 is divided into 20 and 16 so we say twenty seventeen.
 - 1984** = nineteen eighty-four **1990** = nineteen ninety
 - 2012** = twenty twelve - two thousand (and) twelve
 - 2021** = twenty twenty-one – two thousand (and) twenty-one
- We ask:** What date is it today? / What is the date today? / What is the date?

We normally add a "th" to the end of a cardinal number to make it an ordinal number, but there are some exceptions.
