GRAMMAR 1

SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE

• We use the simple present tense to talk about daily routines, habits, regular activities likes & dislikes.

Rules

- We use the base form of the verb to form the present simple tense.
- In general, in the third person singular the verb ends in "-s".
- We add "-es" to verbs ending in "-o, ch, -sh, -ss, -x" or "-z".
- Some verbs end in a consonant + -y. We remove the "-y" and add "-ies" in the third person singular.
- We use "Do" or "Does" before the subject to make a question in the simple present tense.
- We use "do not / don't" or "does not / doesn't" between the subject and the verb to make a negative sentence.

l You We They	get up early.
He She It	gets up early.



Question (?)

Do	l you we they	get up early?
Does	he she it	get up early?



Negative (-)

l You We They	don't get up early.
He She It	doesn't get up early.

- The common question forms we use to ask for the time are: What time is it? / What is the time?
- We use "It is" or "It's" to respond to the questions that ask for the time right now. It is half past six (6:30).

• We use the structure **at + time** when giving the time of a specific event.



GRAMMAR 3

ORDINAL NUMBERS

- We use ordinal numbers to tell the dates.
- There are two ways of giving the date in English.

Month + Day: January 25 - January the twenty fifth

Day + Month: 25th January – The twenty fifth of January

• Years are normally divided into two parts; the first two digits and the last two digits.

2016 is divided into 20 and 16 so we say twenty seventeen.

1984 = nineteen eighty-four **1990** = nineteen ninety

2012 = twenty twelve - two thousand (and) twelve

2021 = twenty twenty-one - two thousand (and) twenty-one

• We ask: What date is it today? / What is the date today? / What is the date?

We normally add a "th" to the end of a cardinal number to make it an ordinal number, but there are some exceptions.
